SUMMARY

The Director of Educators Network is responsible for the operation of TAF's Educators Network focused on promoting racial equity in public schools.

The Educators Network has two arms: The Martinez Fellowship Program is focused on and committed to improving teacher diversity and retaining teachers of color in WA State through partnerships with universities and districts. The second arm of the Educators Network is the Network for Edwork, which is committed to connecting and supporting rising and established education leaders of color in WA State.

The Director of Educators Network is charged with the development and expansion of both the Martinez Fellowship, and Network for Edwork. This role will ensure that both programs are chronicled and packaged in such a way that they can be scaled throughout Washington State to ensure the retention and development of teachers and leaders of color in Washington State.

Vision

- Provide strategic leadership to the Educators Network through system development aligned to the achievement of the Educators Network mission and vision
- Develop and expand both the Martinez Fellowship, and Network for Edwork.
- Ensure that both programs are chronicled and packaged in such a way that they can be scaled throughout Washington State

- Meet with college of education leadership to expand Martinez and Network for Edwork partners to establish and develop working relationships
- Meet with district leadership to expand and develop working relationships for purposes of placing Fellows for student teaching and/or full-time position placements
- Oversee annual school district visits by Program Manager and Coordinator to facilitate visits to schools Fellows are teaching
- Fosters a professional learning culture grounded in adult learning theory and research-based instructional strategies
- Conducts and coordinates evaluations of the Educator Networks Program Managers and Program Coordinator
