TAF is a Seattle-based nonprofit leader that partners with local schools, universities, corporations, and community to equip underrepresented K-12 students with free public STEM education and tools to enter college and careers. Since 1996, TAF has worked to create opportunities for students to access traditionally white, male dominated industries by providing industry relevant technical skills, career experiences, and supportive academic environments to encourage early discovery of career pathways. We also work with educators, so more students can learn in an unbiased, equitable environment where the ethnic make-up of the teaching staff is representative of the student body. Through our cohesive programs – School Transformation, Network for EdWork and our model academies TAF@Saghalie and TAF@ Washington Middle School – we impact over 24,000 public school students and teachers across Washington State.
